

DECLARATION ON PERSISTENT ORGANIC POLLUTANTS (POPs)

The Stockholm Convention on Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs) was formally approved on May 22, 2001, in Stockholm, Sweden and became effective on May 17, 2004. This global treaty was established to protect human health and the environment from chemicals that remain intact and persistent in the environment, as well as in humans and animals, for prolonged durations.

TRANCERIE EMILIANE SPA declares that no Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs) are present in the components and/or parts of the products it manufactures for its customers. To the extent of our knowledge, all our parts comply with the POPs Regulation (EU) 2019/2021 and all its subsequent amendments and additions (including the consolidated version of December 2025). Our parts do not contain substances subject to bans or restrictions listed in Annex I of said Regulation.

TRANCERIE EMILIANE SPA does not use POPs in the materials we purchase nor in our production processes.

Our continuous due diligence in product sourcing is essential to keep current with of any regulatory revisions, ensuring that our products always remain compliant with this directive.
