



RoHS ACTUALIZATION 2023

Consolidated RoHS III Text (Ed. 19.0 dd. 22/09/2022)

TRANCERIE EMILIANE S.p.A declares that all parts supplied to your company are produced in compliance with the RoSH III Directive, and with subsequent amendments of the European Parliament, and the Delegated Directive (EU) 2022/1631 of the Commission. The Delegated Directive (EU) 2022/1631 of the Commission dd. 12th May 2022, concerning the exemption for the use of lead both in bismuth, strontium, calcium, and copper oxide superconducting cables and wires, and in the relevant electrical connections.

The Delegated Directive (EU) 2022/1632 of the Commission dd. 12th May 2022, related to the exemption for the use of lead in certain diagnostic devices for magnetic resonance imaging.

We also report the publication of the Decree of the Ministry of Ecological Transition of 4th August 2022 (GU n.202 dd.30-8-2022) containing the implementation of the Directive 2011/65/EU on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment.

The Delegated Directive 2023/171, which modifies Annex III of the RoHS Directive, as regards the exemption relating to the use of hexavalent chromium as an anti-corrosion agent in gas-fired absorption heat pumps, has been published. The exemption applies only to equipment category 1, by 31st August 2023, the laws, regulations and administrative provisions necessary to comply with the Directive, and apply these provisions starting from 1st September 2023.
